

TENT PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Tents less than 60m² (656 ft²) in area

No Building permit required

Tents between 61 m² (656 ft²) and 225 m² (2421 ft²) in area, tents closer than 3 m (9.8 ft) to other tents or structures, contain bleachers, or area enclosed with sidewalls

Building permit required

Tents greater than 225 m2 (2421 ft2) in area

Building permit required

 Professional Engineer must design the supporting framing structure and anchorage system, sign a commitment to review form then inspect the tent after it is erected and before it is put in use.

Requirements for Building Permit application:

- Application form "Permit to Construct or Demolish" The *description of work* line should include the dimensions of the tent, the words *temporary tents* and the duration of time for which the tent is to remain on site (i.e. 40'x40' Temporary Tent, August 6 to 12)
- 2 Copies of Site Plan
- 2 Copies of tent drawings designed by a qualified person (provided by tent company)
- Certificate of flame resistance conforming to CAN/ULC S-109-M or NFPA 701

In addition, tents greater than 225m2 (2421ft2) in area require:

- 2 Copies of Professional Engineer supporting structure and anchorage details including designer information described
- Commitment Form for Professional Engineer

Note:

Period for which permit shall be issued or refused for a tent permit is 10 working days. Tent permit application for garden centres may require Site Plan Approval.
